KEY KNOWLEDGE:

QUESTION 1: What do humans need in their habitat?

ANSWER

All forms of life from Humans to cows, bears to flowers need certain things to live. Survival depends upon getting enough food, water, cover and places to raise their young. Cover may mean from sun or bad weather as well as from predators. Humans build houses for cover and places to raise young. A Human habitat though is much bigger than a house, it is the entire neighbourhood where they live, buy food and all the services it provides.

QUESTION 2: What do different animals eat?

ANSWER

Animals can be put into groups based on the types of food they eat. Some animals called carnivores only eat meat. Others are called 'herbivores'. They only eat plants. Animals that eat meat and plants are called 'omnivores'
