Percentage of Pupils achieving the Expected Standard or above compared to their 16/17 Attendance

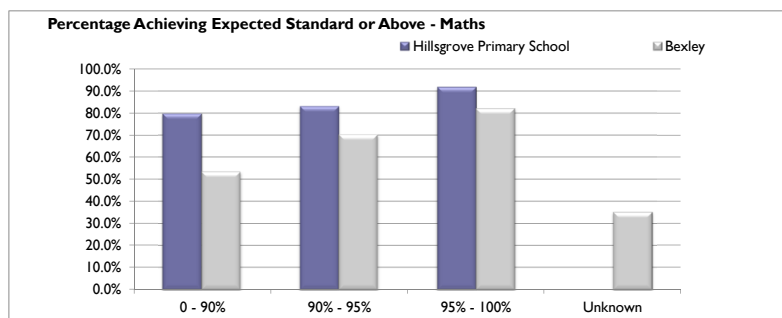

Methodology for Calculating Progress

- Calculate the combined Key Stage 1 average points score (APS) for Reading, Writing and Maths
- The Key Stage 1 APS is equally weighted for English (Reading and Writing) and Maths
- Assign each pupil a Prior Attainment Group (PAG) based on their combined APS  
(The table to the left shows the 21 PAGs)
- For each PAG, the national Key Stage 2 averaged scaled score is calculated by subject
- The average scaled score for Writing is calculated using the following 2016 conversions:  
Working Towards the Expected Standard - 91  
Working at the Expected Standard - 103  
Working at Greater Depth - 113
- A pupil's progress score is the difference between their own scaled score and the emerging 2017 national average Key Stage 2 result for their prior attainment group
- The average progress score is 0
- A school's progress scores is the average of all their pupils' progress scores for each subject.  
School level progress scores will be presented as positive, negative or 0

Progress Calculation includes: pupils with Key Stage 1 results and pupils who are below the level of the test and have a TA outcome of BLW, PKF, PKE or PKF.
