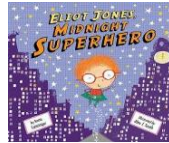


Year R – Summer Term 2 2019 – Homework Menu

Literacy:

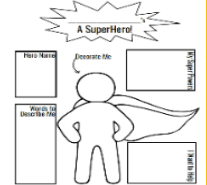
- *Practice letter sounds using the

- *What shapes might be on your hero's costume?
- *What you might call your superhero?
- * Label all this on your design.



Write about it

Can you write a story about your own superhero? Describe your superhero. Can you give your superhero a name? What other characters will be in your story?



Think about:

- *Saying your sentence before you write
- *The sounds you hear in each word
- *How to form the letters

Extra Challenges:

- *Have you got spaces between each word?
- *Have you used capital letters correctly?
- *Have you used full stops correctly?
