


Year 2 – Summer Term 2 2019 – Homework Menu

<p>This half term, we will be looking at explorers from the past and the present. There are books in the school library and local libraries, but you could also read:</p> <p>Sunita Williams-E book Race to South Pole-Roland Huntford Ladybird Great Explorers Series</p> <p>Remember to focus on:</p> <p>Vocabulary – Inference – Predict – Explain – Retrieve – Summarise</p> 	<p>We will be learning about Ibn Battuta, Captain James Cook, Sunita Williams and Roald Amundsen. We would like you to research their expeditions. You could also research what was known about the places they discovered before their discovery. For example, what was Australia like before it was 'discovered'?</p> <p>Where else have humans explored?</p> 	<p>Design a boat to travel across water like Captain James Cook's boat, Endeavour.</p>   <p>Design your own exploration vehicle. Think about where you want to explore and create a detailed, labelled diagram.</p>
Practise it	Write about it	Make a project
<p>Maths – Practise counting in 2's, 3's, 5's and 10's from any given number.</p> <p>Find $\frac{1}{2}$, $\frac{1}{4}$, $\frac{3}{4}$, $\frac{1}{3}$ and $\frac{2}{3}$ of a number.</p> <p>Spellings- Practise spelling the year 1/2 common exception words that have been given to you, e.g. they, you, most, many...</p> <p>Reading- please read as frequently as possible, asking your child questions about the book.</p>	<p>Write a diary as if you were Amundsen or Scott on their way to the South Pole. Could you include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Adjectives to describe the feeling on all five senses. • Adverbials of time to show when things happened. • Punctuation. • Check that each sentence makes sense. <p>Pick a completely different genre (a poem, a story, a play...) to write about an exploration you have been on...</p>	<p>Following on from your research task, you could present what you have found out as a leaflet, Power Point or fact file.</p>
